## Canberra 2019 Excursion – Important Information

### Departure Day – Monday 5 August

- All students need to wear their Caningeraba Year 6 **Senior Shirt**, Canberra tracksuit and beanie.
- Drop off your child at Gold Coast Domestic airport at **7.00am**. Mr McConnell and Ms Mott will be there to greet your child upon arrival at the drop off zone so there is no need for you to come into the airport.
- Students will need their own **Morning Tea and Afternoon Tea** (lunch is provided). Please ensure your child has enough healthy snacks to keep them going. No lollies.

### Packing for Snow Day

- Pack all snow day clothing inside an easily identifiable, drawstring bag. Include leggings/tights/or skins, waterproof ski gloves, and snow goggles.
- Include one pair of long thin woollen socks to be worn under ski boots. See attached checklist for further packing requirements.
- There is no need for snow jackets or pants. We have hired them from the venue and they are very difficult to fit in the suitcases to come back home!
